UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

On 21.4.2014, this Court recorded following submissions made on behalf of Mr. Mukul Rohtagi, learned senior counsel for the State of Haryana:

"Perused the letter. I.A. No. 3 filed in S.L.P.(C) No. 8971 of 2014, for intervention is allowed. The applicants in I.A. No. 3 have stated that they and such other licensees are not interested in re-opening and running liquor vends on the State Highways. The above statement is hereby recorded. Mr. Mukul Rohtagi, learned senior counsel appearing for the State of Haryana, has no objection in recording the above statement. List both the matters on 6th May, 2014."

Learned senior counsel for the State of Haryana submitted that similar matters with respect to State of Tamil Nadu is pending before this Court in Special Leave to Appeal (Civil) No. 14911-14913 of 2013 titled as "The State of Tamil Nadu Rep. by Sec. and Ors. v. K. Balu and Anr.". In view of such submission, we direct to list these cases along with Special Leave to Appeal (Crl.) No. 14911-14913 of 2013.

In the meantime, the respondent shall not take any coercive step against the applicant in I.A. No. 3 of 2014 in Special Leave Petition (C) No. 8971 of 2014 on the ground that they are not interested in reopening and running of such liquor vends on the State Highways. However, it will be open to State authorities to recover the arrears, if any, from the concerned parties.
