O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 17.11.2025 passed in Misc. Criminal Case No.50649/2025 and the judgment and order dated 02.12.2025 passed in Misc. Criminal Case No.55491/2025 by the High Court of Madhya Pradesh at Gwalior.
2. The total sum alleged to have been misappropriated is Rs.31,07,661/- (Rupees Thirty-One Lakhs Seven Thousand Six

Hundred Sixty-One only). The petitioner undertakes to deposit fifty per cent (50%) of the said amount before the Registry of this Court within a period of two weeks from today. The amount so deposited shall be kept in a short-term fixed deposit (duration: six months) with an auto-renewal option in any nationalized bank.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 20.02.2026.

4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one week.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to serve the learned standing counsel for the State of Madhya Pradesh.

6. In the notice itself, it shall be mentioned that the respondent is required to file the counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

7. In the meanwhile, the condition stipulated in paragraph no.7 of the impugned judgment/order dated 17.11.2025 shall remain stayed.
