objections sent by him. Keeping in view the fact that the respondent has also a

residential flat at Mumbai and he is normally on voyage, we are of the opinion that no prejudice shall be caused to him if M.C.No. 160/2004 pending before the Family Court,

Belgaum at Karanataka titled as Srikant Ghadi Vs. Manisha is transferred to the

Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai.
