UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court; hence, the special leave petition is dismissed.
2. At this stage, Mr. Anand Sanjay M. Nuli, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, prays that the petitioner may be given reasonable time to vacate the decretal property.

3. We grant the petitioner a month's time from date to vacate the decretal property, subject to filing of the usual undertaking within a week from date.
4. In the event the undertaking is not filed within a week, the protective order passed shall stand automatically vacated.
5. In such an event, the decree holder shall be at liberty to continue with the execution proceedings in accordance with law.
