These matters were taken up at the Supreme Court Lok Adalat with the consent  
and agreement through their counsel. The following order/award is passed :-

Leave granted. Delay condoned.

The claimant has filed these appeals one against the original order of the High

Court and the other against the order passed in the Review Application. The concerned

MACT has awarded a

sum of Rs.1,10,000/-. The amount was affirmed in appeal by the claimant. Considering the peculiar facts of these cases, we direct that, in addition to a sum of Rs.1,38,000/- which is stated to have been paid, a further sum of Rs.1,10,000/- be paid within a period of three weeks. The amount would be deposited with the concerned MACT and the claimant is permitted to withdraw the same.

Both these appeals are disposed of accordingly.
