UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the husband of the petitioner was arrested and has already been released on bail. The petitioner herself was granted interim bail by the High Court on 13.05.2025, subject to the condition that she shall attend the police station every Monday of each week. She duly complied

with the direction and cooperated with investigation until the application for pre-arrest bail came to be dismissed on 19.12.2025.

2. Though the FIR was registered on 15.01.2025, the chargesheet has not been filed till date.

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable on 13.02.2026.

4. Mr. Aaditya Aniruddha Pande, learned Advocate-on-Record, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent NO.1.

5. Service on respondent No.2 be effected through the concerned Station House Officer.

6. In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer in connection with FIR No.0051 of 2025 dated 15th January, 2025 registered at Lonikand Police Station, District Pune City, Maharashtra. Needless to add that the petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation.
