We have carefully gone through the order under review and the review petitions. We called for the paper-books in Civil Appeal Nos.5594, 5641 & 5674 of 2001 and on verification we find that the averment that the same point is involved in these cases, is not correct. Whereas in the present appeals (C.As.7426-7427/2001) the question is whether dismissal of the appeals by the Tribunal for not making pre-deposit to entertain the appeals, is valid, in the said Civil Appeals (Nos.5594, 5641 & 5674 of 2001), the question relates to the classification of goods. We find absolutely no merit in the review petitions. They are accordingly dismissed.
