O R D E R

1. Application for impleadment is allowed.
2. Amended memo of parties be filed within one week.
3. New impleaded respondents shall file response to the main petition within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.
4. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions would reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.
5. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Mediation Centre attached to the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, Nagpur on 4th May 2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.
6. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.
7. List the matter along with the Mediation Report on 15.07.2026.
8. Interim order granted earlier shall continue.
