This is an appeal preferred by the State challenging the acquittal of the respondent in a

case filed against him under Sections 7 and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Section 218

IPC. The allegation against the respondent was that he had received a sum of Rs.90/- as bribe from PW

1. The respondent had set up a plea that he received the said sum from PW 1 towards the welfare fund

and he had issued a receipt to PW 1 against the same. This plea was accepted by the Special Judge as

well as the learned Single Judge of the High Court. We do not find that the view taken by the Special

Judge as unreasonable and we see no reason to interfere with the same.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
