We find no reason to entertain this special leave petition at this Stage since the High Court has passed an order admitting the revision preferred by the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to our notice following earlier order dated 8.11.2011 passed by the High Court in the said revision:

"I am not inclined to interfere in the impugned order, whereby the summoning of the wife at the behest of the husband has been declined. The counsel, however, contends that if the parties are summoned there may be a scope of settling the issue amicably.
Notice of motion for 25.1.2012 to see in case there is any possibility to settle the issues."

Under these circumstances, we request the High Court to dispose of the matter within a period of two months.
The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
