UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E RThough there is a delay of 391 days in filing the  
Special Leave Petition, we dispose this Special Leave  
Petition by reserving liberty to the petitioner to seek  
expeditious disposal of the case pending before the High

Court.

We find that the matter is now to be listed before the High Court on 12.02.2026. On that day, the petitioner is at liberty to press for an early disposal of his case or in the alternative, to seek vacating of the interim stay granted by the High Court.

It is needless to observe that if any of the aforesaid requests is made by the petitioner herein, the same shall be taken into consideration having regard to the facts of the case and as alleged by the petitioner-wife and in accordance with law as early as possible and preferably within a period of four months from today.

We say so for the reason that the High Court has stayed by its interim order the proceedings that have been filed by the petitioner herein under the provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.

Consequently, all pending application(s), if any, including application seeking condonation of delay, shall also stand disposed of.
