Heard learned counsel for both the parties.

The appellants herein were convicted under Section 326 IPC read with Section 34 IPC and Section 324 IPC read with Section 34 IPC. They filed appeal before the High Court and the High Court reduced the sentence to two years.

Learned counsel for the complainant Harmail Singh has filed an application for impleadment. We heard the learned counsel for the complainant. The complainant and the appellants settled their dispute amicably and they want to live in peace.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, we confirm their sentence under Section 326/34 IPC and under Section 324/34 IPC but reduce the sentence to one year rigorous imprisonment on each count and sentence on both counts to run concurrently.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
