The present special leave petition by the Committee of Management is directed against the interim order of the Division Bench of the Allahabad High Court, Lucknow Bench dated 24.11.2001. By the said order, the Division Bench stayed the interim order passed by the learned Single Judge dated 29.10.2001. The matter has not been heard thereafter by the Division Bench.

We are not inclined to interfere with the interim order of the Division Bench. We would, however, observe that the Division Bench would do well in disposing of the Special Appeal as expeditiously as possible, preferably when the learned Chief Justice sits next at Lucknow. We also further

observe that the pendency of the Special Appeal before the Division Bench which is, in fact, in relation to the legality of an interim order passed by the learned Single Judge, would not stand on the way of the learned Single Judge to hear and dispose of the writ petition itself, who may do so early. This special leave petition stands disposed of accordingly.
