O R D E R

The Registry has raised an objection that the special leave petition is barred by 313 days. In the application for condonation of delay it has

been stated by the deponent that as soon as the judgment was pronounced by the High Court, an application was made for a certified copy thereof and it is still not ready. If the above statement is correct, it is open to the petitioners to take appropriate proceedings after the copy is available to them.
