This petition has been filed by the Narcotics Control Bureau against the bail granted to the respondent in an offence under the N.D.P.S. Act.

The bail itself was granted on 14.7.2000 and the application for cancellation thereof was filed which stood rejected on 9.4.2001. The special leave petition was filed in this Court on 10.1.2002. The accused-respondent has been on ...2

bail for more than two years and there is not an iota of assertion that he has either misutilized the liberty that was granted or that he has indulged in commission of any further offence for which he is charged.

In these circumstances, we are not inclined to invoke our jurisdiction under Article 136 of the Constitution of

India to cancel the bail that has been granted. The special leave petition accordingly stands rejected.
