Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the
relevant material.

We do not find any legal and valid ground for interference.
The special leave petition is dismissed.

However, it is brought to our notice that the condition
imposed by the Additional District and Sessions Judge, namely, that
"the petitioner shall not enter into the jurisdiction of the police
station within which the witnesses of the case reside", is onerous.
Accordingly, we permit the petitioner to file appropriate
application for modification before the court concerned, namely, the
Court of Additional District and Sessions Judge, FTC-4, Barrackpore,
West Bengal. If any such application is filed, the court concerned
is free to consider and pass appropriate order.
