UPON perusing papers the Court made the following  
ORDER

The petitioner has challenged the orders dated 9/9/2005 and 5/10/2005 passed by the Registrar of this Court declining to register an application filed by the petitioner seeking review of

the order dated 12.1.2005 in Curative Petition No.82/2004. The petitioner had earlier filed SLPs. against the order passed by the Division Bench of the Allahabad High Court. The SLPs. were dismissed. Thereafter, the petitioner moved review petitions. They were also dismissed. Then a Curative Petition was filed by the petitioner. That was also dismissed on 12.1.2005. Thereafter, he filed an application seeking reconsideration of the order passed in the Curative Petition, which was lodged vide order dated 15.6.2005. Thereafter he filed an application for reconsideration of the order dated 12.1.2005. That was lodged on 10.8.2005.

The petitioner has again filed the present application for review of order dated 12.1.2005 dismissing the curative petition. The Registrar has lodged the application on

9.9.2005. The petitioner filed another application dated 26.9.2005 for rectifying the order dated 5.10.2005 passed by the Registrar. That was lodged on 5.10.2005.

Thereafter he filed the present application terming it as 'Misc. Appeal' for quashing the orders dated 5.10.2005 and 9.9.2005 of the Registrar. No such application or appeal is maintainable. The orders of the Registrar do not suffer from any infirmity and there is no reason to interfere with the said orders passed by the Registrar.
