O R D E R

It is stated on behalf of the petitioners that the respondent No.1 has been reinstated in February 2003. So far as the payment of salary after reinstatement is concerned, it is provided that the respondent shall be

paid the same salary which she was getting at the time of termination of her services. The amount which is due from March 2003 up to date shall be cleared within four weeks. So far as the back wages are concerned that would obviously be subject to the final decision of the writ petitions pending in the High Court.

Since the writ petitions are pending in the Bombay High Court, Aurangabad Bench, all the points raised by the parties shall remain open to be canvassed before the High Court. So far as these petitions are concerned, nothing more is required to be done. All the petitions accordingly stand finally disposed of.
