O R D E R

1. This petition is filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, seeking transfer of Family Suit No. 969/2025 titled "*Neeraj Kumar Janak Nandankandpal vs. Poonam Neeraj Kumar Kandpal*", pending before the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Vadodara, Gujarat to the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Haldwani, District Nainital, Uttarakhand.

2. The grounds raised by the petitioner for seeking the transfer are that she is dependent on her elder sister; and on account of long distance she is unable to effectively defend the proceedings at Vadodara.

3. On such consideration, we are of the view that the transfer can be allowed. Consequently, the Transfer Petition is allowed.

4. Accordingly, Family Suit No. 969/2025 titled "*Neeraj Kumar Janak Nandankandpal vs. Poonam Neeraj Kumar Kandpal*", pending before the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Vadodara, Gujarat is transferred to the Court of learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Haldwani, District Nainital, Uttarakhand.

5. The transferor Court shall forward the records pertaining to the said case to the transferee Court, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Court on 11th May, 2026.

7. The respondent-husband is permitted to attend the proceedings virtually, unless his presence is required by the trial Court.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
