UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Application seeking permission to file the Special Leave Petition without certified copy/plain copy of the impugned Order passed by the High Court is granted.

2. Exemption Application is allowed.

3. We heard Mr. N. Venkataraman, the learned Additional Solicitor General appearing for the petitioner - IFCI Limited and Mr. Rajiv Shakhder, the learned Senior counsel, who is on caveat, appearing for the Respondents.

4. By Our Order dated 16-10-2025, we had requested the High Court to see that the Civil Writ Petitions are taken up for hearing and those are disposed of on or before 31-10-2025.

5. The impugned Order passed by the High Court reads thus:-

"It is informed that due to inadvertent typographical error in the order dated 13.11.2025, the next date of hearing was mentioned as "20.01.2026" instead of "20.11.2025".

"Accordingly, the aforesaid typographical error is hereby rectified. The next date of hearing i.e. "20.01.2026" shall be read as "20.11.2025" for all intents and purposes. The order dated 13.11.2025 stands modified to the above extent. Remaining part of the order dated 13.11.2025 remains intact.

Arguments heard in part.

For remaining arguments, adjourned to 08.12.2025,

6. We request the High Court to make all endeavors to see that the appeals are heard finally and are disposed of with final Judgment.

7. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.
