In the meantime, it is provided that in the event of arrest of the petitioners in connection with Case Crime No. 455 of 2024, registered at PS Kotwali Orai, District Jalaun, he shall be released on a personal bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand), subject to an undertaking that he shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available as and when required by the Investigating Officer and shall neither threaten the witnesses nor tamper with the evidence.
