O R D E R

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was aged 17 years, 4 months at the time of the alleged offence and thus cannot be tried under the provisions of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and his case is required to be referred to the Juvenile Justice Board.

2. Thus, he submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition to move before the Trial Court for referring the petitioner's case to the Juvenile Justice Board for appropriate

inquiry.

3. Having regard to aforesaid, the present petition stands disposed of as withdrawn, with liberty aforesaid.

4. For two weeks, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No. 55 of 2025 dated 07.02.2025.
