UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The delay of 66 days in filing the application for
restoration is condoned.

Pre-emptory order dated 19.07.2013 was passed directing the
petitioners to surrender and furnish proof thereof within four weeks
failing which the special leave petition was directed to be dismissed
for non-prosecution.

Since the petitioners did not surrender within the time
granted, the special leave petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

The petitioners have surrendered but with some delay, i.e.,
on 20.08.2013. Thus, there is a delay of only four days in
surrendering which is condoned. As a consequence, order dated
19.07.2013 is recalled and the special leave petition is restored to
its original number.
