## O R D E R

1. We have heard Mr. Mukul Rohatgi, learned senior counsel for the petitioner.
2. The grievance in the instant Special Leave Petitions is against the interim order(s) passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana in terms whereof the petitioner has been restrained from cutting the trees on the site where some commercial complex is proposed to be developed.
