UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. The petitioner is aggrieved by an interlocutory injunction order dated 07.01.2026 passed by a Division Bench of the Uttarakhand High Court. One of the grievances is that the order has been passed without even hearing the petitioner.

2. It seems to us that the correct recourse for the petitioner would be to approach the High Court through appropriate applications for its impleadment as a party-respondent; to seek vacation/modification of the interim order; and to bring on record the set of facts based on which the petitioner claims that the Song

River, near the site where the petitioner-stone crusher is operational, is non-perennial. Since the High Court is reopening after the winter vacation on 09.02.2026, we request the High Court to entertain these applications and pass appropriate orders by preponing the next date of hearing.

3. With liberty aforementioned, the special leave petition is disposed of.

4. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
