We may only notice at this stage that the counsel for the petitioner contends before us

that the question as to whether the respondent, a retired employee of the I.D.P.L. can be considered to

be specified landlord has been the subject matter of decision of this Court in the case of Officers and

Supervisors of IDPL Vs. Chairman & M.D., I.D.P.L. & Ors. 2003 (6) SC C, 490 which holds that he

cannot claim the status of a specified landlord under the Act. He also submits that the High Court is

not right in stating that in the earlier revision petition filed by the petitioner the plea of the

respondent not being a specified landlord has not been raised and in this connection he draws out

attention to the grounds at page 42 of the paperbook.

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Issue notice.

Counsel for respondent present on caveat accepts notice and prays for one week's time to

file counter affidavit. As prayed for, one week's time is granted to file counter affidavit. Rejoinder, if

any, may be filed within one week thereafter. Put up this matter soon thereafter.
