UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. K.M. Nataraj, learned ASG on behalf of the State of Rajasthan and other official respondents.
2. In our considered opinion, no case to interfere with the administrative exercise of delimitation undertaken by the State of Rajasthan for the purpose of reconstitution of Gram Panchayat, is made out. Furthermore, we find that the High Court has thoroughly examined all the factual and legal aspects, and no infringement of any constitutional or legally vested right has been identified. The special leave petitions are, accordingly, dismissed.
3. Further, it goes without saying that if the Gram Panchayat faces any difficulty in its management or in providing services to the residents of the village, it will be at liberty to approach the competent authority to shift its headquarters.
4. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
