ORDER

The present Review Petition has been filed seeking review of our order dated 19th January, 2009 whereby we declined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner herein with liberty to the petitioner to appear before the concerned Court within 15 days from 19 th January, 2009. It was also directed that his bail application shall be considered and decided the same day.

It appears that instead of surrendering before the concerned

Court within the aforesaid time, petitioner has preferred the present review petition.

Having carefully gone through the review petition and the connected papers, we do not find any ground to review the aforesaid order declining anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Since the period of 15 days to appear before the concerned

court has already expired, we grant another seven days to the petitioner to appear/surrender before the concerned court and apply for regular bail. If such an application is moved, we direct the court concerned to decide the application for bail on the same day in accordance with law.

The Review Petition is dismissed in the above terms.
