O R D E R

These appeals are directed against the judgments rendered in F.A. nos. 109, 120-121/93, 210-216, 254-256, 258, 261-263, 267-269, 274, 279/1994, 102-03/1993, 251-253, 260, 264, 270-273, 275-278, 280-282/1994 by the High Court of Orissa. It is not disputed that the High Court dismissed these appeals following the decision in F.A. nos. 287 and 327/1990 passed by the High Court. It is further not disputed that the appeals arising out of F.A. Nos. 287 & 327/1990 have been allowed by this Court in the case of Executive Director vs. Sarat Chandra Bisoi & anr (2000) 6 SCC 326.

In that view of the matter, the judgment under challenge is modified and the appeals are disposed of in terms of the judgment in the case of Executive Director vs. Sarat Chandra Bisoi & anr (supra). There shall be no order as to costs.
