UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner has been denied anticipatory bail by the High Court in connection with FIR No.154/2025 dated 09.03.2025, registered with Police Station, Mukheijee Nagar for the offence punishable under Sections 110/3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short, "the BNS") (erstwhile Section 308 of the Indian Penal Code).

2. We heard Mr. Aditya Dhawan, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. D.P. Singh, the learned Additional Solicitor

General appearing for the State of NCT of Delhi.

3. Having regard to the case put up by the prosecution and also having regard to the nature of offence with which the petitioner is alleged to be charged with, we are persuaded to exercise our discretion in favour of the petitioner.

4. In view of the aforesaid, we direct that in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail subject to terms and conditions that the Investigating Officer may deem fit to impose.

5. Once the petitioner is released by the I.O., the petitioner shall thereafter appear before the trial court and furnish fresh bail.

6. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

7. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
