petitioner.In the impugned order, the High Court was of the
view that it was a fit case for grant of anticipatory bail but,
while granting the said privilege, it directed the petitioner
to deposit

the sum of Rs.50,000/- before the learned Magistrate as a
condition of bail. Passing of such orders has been
deprecatd by this Court times without number.Accordingly, we modify the impugned order to the extent
that the petitioner shall not be required to deposit the sum
of Rs.50,000/- before the learned Magistrate but we direct
that, in the event of arrest or surrender, the petitioner shall
be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/-
with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of
the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur.Needless to say that in case the respondent-State of
Punjab feels aggrieved by this order, it would be open to it

to move this court for recall for this order.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed
of.
