O R D E R

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the impugned order.

The impugned order is in the nature of an interim order stating that no coercive step should be taken as against the respondent-accused till 28.02.2024.

As the said order is limited in nature and only till 28.02.2024, it is expected that the High Court would weigh all circumstances and consider the case on merits before extending the

said order any further.

Having regard to the tenor of the impugned order, despite the pendency of the petition before the High Court, there is no impediment for the investigation of the case to be carried on by the police. It is needless to observe that the respondent-accused shall cooperate with the investigation agency.

With the aforesaid observations, the Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of.
