ORDER

This appeal is directed against the order dated 16.10.2000 passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi.

By the impugned order, the electric connection of the appellant has been restored, which was the main prayer of the appellant. The appellant also claimed certain compensation. The

Commission observed that examination of evidence may be produced in the full scale trial and not in summary proceedings. The Commission further observed that the appellant would be at liberty to seek any other remedy available to him before any other appropriate forum.

In our considered opinion, the view taken by the Commission seems to be reasonable. No interference is called for. The appeal being devoid of any merit is accordingly dismissed.
