O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. Application seeking impleadment of legal heirs of the deceased petitioner no.2. in WP No. 7496/2023, in a Special Leave Petition challenging the Writ Petition is allowed. Amended memo of parties be filed within a week.

3. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners would submit that once an amendment is allowed by the Trial Court, it always relate back to the date of filing of the suit and therefore, the High Court has completely erred in observing that the Doctrine of Relation Back would not apply to the subject amendment and the same would be operative only from the date the amendment was sought.

4. Issue notice, returnable in eight weeks.

5. In the meanwhile, further proceedings in Regular First Appeal pending before the District Judge, shall remain stayed.
