UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. In view of the fact that the matter is now coming before the High Court for hearing on 12.03.2026, we are not inclined to entertain this special leave petition. The petitioner may request the High Court to take up the matter for final disposal. However, we do not hesitate in observing that the High Court is absolutely correct in exploring the possibility of an amicable solution between the parties. The High Court, in this regard, may segregate

the petitioner - mother from the influence of her son for some time and allow her to take an independent decision as to whether she would still prefer to oust her daughter completely from the family property.

2. A senior mediator, in this regard, can help the parties in resolving the dispute amicably.

3. With these observations, the special leave petition is disposed of.

4. All pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
