O R D E R

It is a classification dispute in respect of items known as printed cartons, catch covers, wrappers, etc.

The period involved is 01.04.1991 to 31.03.1994 in which the show cause notice was issued only on 14.10.1996 invoking extended period of limitation.

was After the reply to this show cause notice submitted by the assessee-respondent, the adjudicating authority itself dropped the demand on the ground that the notice was barred by limitation and the extended period of limitation was not applicable in view of approval of the classification list by the authorities itself.

been The order of the adjudicating authority has upheld by the Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal vide the impugned decision. The issue of limitation is discussed in detail in paragraph 4 thereof and the findings on this issue are flawless.

We, therefore, do not find any merit in this appeal, which is accordingly, dismissed.
