O R D E R

1. This petition is filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure seeking transfer of Original Civil Suit No. 468 of 2025 titled "*Shivay Kalra vs. Aayushi Singh*", pending before the Court of learned First Additional Principal Judge, Roorkee, Uttarakhand to a competent Court of equivalent jurisdiction at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.

2. The grounds raised by the petitioner for seeking the transfer are that she is pursuing her studies and dependent on her parents; and also on account of long distance she is unable to effectively defend the proceedings at Roorkee.

3. On such consideration, we are of the view that the transfer can be allowed. Consequently, the Transfer Petition is allowed.

4. Accordingly, the case being Original Civil Suit No. 468 of 2025 titled "*Shivay Kalra vs. Aayushi Singh*", pending before the Court of learned First Additional Principal Judge, Roorkee, Uttarakhand is transferred to a competent Court of Equivalent Jurisdiction at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.

5. The transferor Court shall forward the records pertaining to the said case to the transferee Court, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Parties are directed to appear before the concerned Court on 13<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.

7. The Respondent-husband is permitted to attend the proceedings virtually, unless his presence is required by the trial Court.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
