The applicant-in-person has filed this interlocutory application praying that the Registrar's Order dated 15-3-2013 be set aside. The applicant has sent a letter stating that he is an old person of 70 years and he is suffering from several ailments. He has further stated that in view of his physical condition, he would not be able to appear before this Court and his appearance may be exempted. He has clarified that if he were to appear, he would have only read the contents of the appeal, which the Court can do better. He has further stated that he has nothing more to add.
