We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner. Apart from delay of 64 days in filing the special leave petition, we also find no merit in the special leave petition. Since a belated claim was made, the Labour Court granted only 50% back wages. Moreover, the submission that the respondent could not be reinstated because he was a daily wager is also misconceived. In case of reinstatement the concerned workman, whose services were terminated, is reinstated on the same post which he held when he was discontinued.

We, therefore, find no merit in this petition. The special leave petition is dismissed both on delay as well as on merits.
