O R D E R

1. Leave granted.
2. The instant appeal is directed against the order dated 06.01.2026 passed by the Gwalior Bench of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh whereby the regular bail granted to the appellant has been cancelled. It may be noticed that the appellant is one of the accused in FIR No.386/2021 registered at P.S. Kolaras, District Shivpuri under Section 409 IPC. The appellant was arrested on 06.01.2024. Thereafter, a chargesheet under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 201 read with Section 13(1) (a), 13(1) (b) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act was filed against the appellant and his co-accused for siphoning off Rs.5.31 crores and his co-accused.
3. The appellant was eventually granted regular bail by the High Court on 18.03.2025. The said order granting bail to the appellant has been cancelled, *inter-alia*, on the ground that the appellant suppressed the material facts regarding the deposit of Rs.47 lakhs in his account etc.

4. We deem it apposite to mention that the regular bail was granted to the appellant after hearing the State counsel. The alleged suppressed facts were not brought to the High Court's notice by the prosecution either. In any case, the trial has commenced. The appellant's co-accused are already on bail. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the appellant in judicial custody. The High Court's previous order granting bail is restored. The appellant is, accordingly, directed to be released on bail subject to the terms and conditions which may be imposed by the trial court.

5. Consequently, the appeal is allowed. The impugned order dated 06.01.2026, passed by the High Court, is set aside.
