This is wife's petition seeking transfer of Divorce Case No. 74 of 2011, Ricky Sharma vs. Shruti Sharma, from the court of District & Sessions Judge, Panchkula, Haryana to the court of District Judge, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.

2. The respondent has appeared pursuant to the notice. As a matter of fact, the matter was referred to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre for resolution of disputes between the parties through the process of mediation.
