UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Complaint Case No. 1141 of 2023 registered with Police Station- Rohtas, District- Rohtas, for the offences punishable under Sections- 406, 420 and 467 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

2. The Petitioner has allegedly obtained a loan amount of Rs.10,40,000/- from the respondent no.2/

complainant and on his refusal to repay the loan, a Criminal Complaint Case No. 1141 of 2023 has been filed by the respondent no.2/ complainant.

3. We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for respondent no.1.

4. None has entered appearance for respondent no.2/ complainant, despite being duly served with the notice.

5. The Petitioner has been granted benefit of interim protection vide order dated 04.02.2026.

6. According to the petitioner, he has already repaid the entire loan amount.

7. Considering the entire fact situation of the case, we deem it appropriate to make the interim order absolute.

8. Accordingly, interim order dated 04.02.2026 is made absolute subject to the condition that petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the trial/ investigation.

9. The Special Leave Petition is accordingly disposed of.

10. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand closed.
