O R D E R

1. **As per the office report dated 16.03.2026, the review petition is defective. Despite being informed, counsel for the petitioner has not cured the defects pointed out by the Registry. However, the matter is taken up on merits.**

Interlocutory Application No. 17985 of 2026

2. **The prayer for listing the Review Petition in the Open Court for hearing is rejected, and the Interlocutory Application stands dismissed.**

Interlocutory Application No. 17984 of 2026

3. **For the view we propose, the prayer to maintain the status quo *vis-à-vis* the subject matter is rejected, and the application stands dismissed.**

Interlocutory Application No. 17987 of 2026

4. **The prayer for calling records set out in the application is**

rejected, for it would be beyond the scope of a Review Petition.

5. We have perused the record and have also taken note of the grounds for review of the Judgment dated 18.12.2025 in Civil Appeal No. 9996 of 2025. The Judgment under review noted that land in an extent of 102 Acres in Survey No. 201/1 Gurranguda Forest Block, Hayathnagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, State of Telangana is forest land, and stood vested in the Government. The view has been taken based on decisions dealing with the subject matter, a detailed perusal and consideration of the records relied on by the Claimants, and submissions on both sides.

6. Having regard to the above, the grounds in the Review Petition are without merit and do not warrant reconsideration of the Judgment dated 18.12.2025 under review. Therefore, the Review Petition stands dismissed.
