O R D E R

1) This application for modification has been filed on behalf of Eklavya Dental College and Hospital seeking direction that the amount as directed to be deposited *vide* order dated 18.12.2025 in Civil Appeal No. 14890 of 2025 of Rs.10 crores may be reduced since they do not have the means to such deposit. Various documents have been filed including balance sheets to show that they do not

have that much amount to pay.

2) We have heard Mr. Vijay Hansaria, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant at length.

3) After hearing, we find that that the order was passed with an intent to save the future of young students who were put into danger by the Dental Colleges governed by the judgment. Therefore, taking a lenient view, deposit of Rs.10 crores was directed to be made by them otherwise it would be recovered as arrears of land revenue. However, not depositing the amount as above and by offering Rs.1 crore, the present application has been filed for modification. In our view, the amount as offered is not at all justified. Moreover, the prayer made to reduce the deposit amount is also not justified looking to the act done by the institutions with the connivance of the officers of the State as well as of the Council. Accordingly, modification as prayed in this miscellaneous application stands dismissed.

4) We make it clear that in case the amount

requisite is not deposited within three months,
further recourse may be directed against the
institution.
