ORDER

1. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Leave granted.

3. We have gone through the Order dated 25.1.2007 of the learned Single Judge of the High Court granting bail with the condition to deposit Rs.75,000/- in the Mahila Court, Magalir Neethimandram, Chennai. We do not think that such a condition could be imposed at this stage by the learned Single Judge. At the time of conclusion of the appeal it would be open to the High Court to award whatever compensation it thinks to be

appropriate but at this stage it will not be proper to impose such kind of condition. Therefore, we only delete from the impugned order the condition of depositing Rs.75,000/- at this stage. However, this will not be understood to mean that we are depriving the victim of the compensation. In case at the time of final disposal of the appeal the High Court thinks it proper to impose that condition, it will be open to it to impose such a condition in accordance with law.

4. With these observations, this appeal stands disposed of.
