2. When the matters were taken up, the Court drew the attention of Mr. V. Prabhakar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner(s) to the fact that on 30.04.2026, a coordinate

Bench of this Court had dismissed the Special Leave Petitions (Diary Nos.1950/2026 & 1957/2026) of the petitioner(s) and refused to interfere with the acquittal of Accused no.2 and Accused no.4, proceedings initiated with regard to one other cheque in question.

3. Mr. V. Prabhakar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner(s) submitted that in the said matters unlike in the matters arising from Diary No(s). 3712/2026 and 1951/2026, there was no averment in the complaint with regard to Accused no.2 and Accused no.4 about they being incharge of and being involved in day to day affairs of the company.

4. Mr. V. Prabhakar, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner(s), however, point out that with regard to Accused no.2 even though the averment was not there, Accused no.2 was a signatory of the cheque.
