O R D E R

We find no reason to interfere as the interim order passed by the High Court appears to be

fair. The High Court has only directed that 50% of the amount deposited be disbursed to the

claimants and the remaining 50% be kept deposited in Fixed Deposit. Counsel for the petitioner states

that the High Court has given liberty to the claimants to seek any further relief if they are so advised

and, therefore, he apprehends that they may seek the release of the balance 50% amount. In our view

the submission of the learned counsel is misconceived as the last sentence of the impugned order does

not have that effect.

With the abovesaid observations the special leave petition is dismissed.
