O R D E R

This petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife for transfer of H.M.A. Petition No.735 of 2012 titled as "Jitender Bains Vs. Neeraj Atma" pending in the Court of Additional District Judge (West) Delhi, Tis Hazari Court, Delhi to the Court of Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, Punjab.

By order dated 19.08.2013, we have referred the matter to the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.

The Supreme Court Mediation Centre has submitted a report showing the terms of the settlement between the parties.

We dispose off this transfer petition in terms of the settlement with the modification that the parties shall withdraw all cases, whether civil or criminal filed against each other, within a period of four weeks from today. Within the aforesaid period, the parties shall file an application for divorce by mutual consent in the Court of Additional District Judge, Jalandhar, Punjab and shall make the first motion within the aforesaid period.

It may be mentioned herein that the amount of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh only) by way of a demand draft bearing no.045185 dated 28.09.2013, which the respondent had agreed to pay at the time of first motion has already been paid to the learned counsel for the petitioner. We record the acknowledgment.

The Settlement Agreement arrived at between the parties shall form part of this order.
