O R D E R

1. In pursuance of the Order passed by this Court dated 30-1-2026, the petitioner - husband has deposited a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) in the Registry of this Court.

5. All proceedings between the parties, civil and criminal, shall remain stayed for the time being.
6. List the matter immediately after receipt of the Mediation Report from the Supreme Court Mediation Centre.
