O R D E R

1. The instant appeal has been directed against a simplicitor order of adjournment passed by the National Company Law Appellate Tribunal, with a further observation that the pendency of the appeal shall not affect the pending proceedings before the adjudicating authority.
2. We are not inclined to entertain this appeal especially when the appellants are at liberty to raise all their contentions before the appellate tribunal.
3. As regard to the plea of urgency, we grant liberty to the appellants to move an appropriate application before the appellate tribunal, which may be considered sympathetically.
4. With this liberty and observation, the appeal is dismissed.
